Australian Tech Company Wins Big at USA Invention Show

StreetSurfer International, an Australian technology company in the midst of expanding its operations on a global scale, picked up three prestigious awards when it unveiled its patented, world first polymer suspension and impact absorption system at the Invention & New Product Exposition (INPEX) held in Pittsburgh USA this month.

Exhibiting at INPEX for the first time in the show's 23 year history, StreetSurfer International showcased its rheopectic impact absorption and suspension technology, as well as the '*StreetSurfer*'; a popular five-wheel cycle that was the first application to utilise the company's unique suspension system.

In an event known as 'the Academy Awards of the invention world', StreetSurfer International was presented with the INPEX *Gold Medal for Specialised Technology*, the Everlast® *Award for Best Design & Engineering on Wheels*, and the Malaysian Invention & Design Society's (MINDS) *Award for Outstanding Invention at INPEX 2007*.

Tony Usher, StreetSurfer International's Chief Executive Officer, travelled to Pittsburgh with Chief Technical Officer Aldo Contarino to attend INPEX and was there to accept the awards on the company's behalf.

Commenting on the value of exhibiting at the INPEX show, Mr Usher stated "It was certainly a very worthwhile exercise for us. In addition to winning three major awards, we received expressions of interest from a number of potential investors, *StreetSurfer* distributors and technology licensees."

The company's award winning suspension technology boasts a tailored, active and controlled response in direct proportion to the speed and force of any impact. Both versatile and efficient, the technology has immeasurable potential across a vast array of industries.

StreetSurfer International also recently attended the world's largest bicycle trade show, Taipei Cycle, to promote its suspension technology for use in the cycle industry. The show was a huge success for the Australian company, with a number of major manufacturers expressing an interest in incorporating its unique polymer design into handlebar, seat post and front and rear cycle suspension applications.

"Having proven the value of our suspension system in the cycle industry, we are now demonstrating its relevance in a number of other industries, including automotive and marine, medical, aviation, engineering, military and more," Mr Usher stated.
